



#### First carotid artery stenting training session



On December 1st, 2023, the first carotid artery stenting training was organized in Breda. With the help of Terumo's simulation models, both experienced and less experienced interventional radiologists were able to practice. # Q & A

Q: Do we have to perform the CTA if the patient has a severely decreased kidney function? A: This is a pragmatic trial and the safety of the patient is the most important. In case of an estimated  $eGFR < 30 \text{ mL/min}/1.73\text{m}^2$  it is okay to skip the CTA. However, we would like you to perform the NCCT.

Q: Does the carotid echo at 3 months have to be performed at the intervention center?

A: The carotid echo should be performed at the intervention center, seeing as payment (if the carotid echo is performed as pasrt of research and not part of routine care!) is made to intervention center based on visits such as the carotid echo. However, if the patient lives far away from the intervention center it is possible to ask a referring center to perform the echo. However, we will not be able to pay the referring center for the carotid echo.
